
## April Monthly Round Up

In April we celebrated Earth Month. We also had many in school activities like Primary Music and Junior Dance. We also congratulate our Gr. 2 students who had their First Communion.










April is Earth Month. Thank you to Mrs. Priolo's class for putting our front display together.




Junior students participating in dance classes hosted by Dance n' Culture.

Mr. Ramdin's class had a real life experience with financial literacy. They had a market and proceeds went towards a field trip for the class.






### **Upcoming Events/Activities**
